



## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

between

**THE STATE SERVICE OF UKRAINE FOR GEODESY,  
CARTOGRAPHY AND CADASTRE (STATEGEOCADASTRE)**

and

**THE AGENCY FOR GEODESY, CARTOGRAPHY AND CADASTRE OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA (AGCC)**

regarding cooperation in the fields of geodesy, cartography, cadastre, land valuation,  
geoinformatics, remote sensing and spatial data infrastructure



The State Service of Ukraine for Geodesy, Cartography and Cadastre and the Agency for Geodesy, Cartography and Cadastre of the Republic of Moldova (hereinafter referred to as “the Participants”),

recognizing friendly relations between Ukraine and the Republic of Moldova,

acknowledging the importance of strengthening international cooperation in the fields of geodesy, cartography, cadastre, geoinformatics, remote sensing, spatial data infrastructure and land valuation,

respecting national legislations and the missions of both Participants,

the Participants have entered into this Memorandum of Understanding have reached the following understanding:

### **Provision 1 - Objective**

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as “Memorandum”), is to establish the cooperation and to encourage the implementation of joint activities between the Participants in the spheres related to geodesy, cartography, cadastre, geoinformatics, remote sensing, spatial data infrastructure and land valuation. Such activities will be carried out on the basis of mutual benefit and equality in accordance with the national legislation of the Participants’ states.

### **Provision 2 – Areas of cooperation**

1. The Participants will, within the limits of their respective competences, cooperate in the following areas of common interest, including but not limited to:

- topographic, geodetic and cartographic activities,
- activities related to geoinformatics and remote sensing,
- maintenance and modernization of cadastral systems,
- activities related to the spatial data infrastructure,
- land valuation,
- operation and development of the geodetic network,
- electronic services and their development in the field of geodesy, cartography and cadastre,
- implementation of digital and automated solutions for spatial data operation,
- cross-border cooperation.

2. The Participants may, by mutual agreement, extend cooperation to other relevant areas.



### **Provision 3 – Forms of cooperation**

1. Cooperation will be carried out by mutual consent of the Participants in the following forms:

- bilateral meetings and other events,
- exchange of experts and delegations through study visits and expert missions,
- organization of visits, consultations, seminars, training programmes and scientific conferences on common issues of the Participants,
- cooperation with subordinate institutions and organizations of the Participants whose field of activity is geodesy, cartography and cadastre,
- creation of joint expert groups for preparing cooperation programs and carrying out the completed programs,
- special working meetings, presentations and workshops,
- dissemination of knowledge and engagement with stakeholders in the field of geodesy, cartography and spatial data infrastructure,
- exchange of information on the specific activities and achievements of the Participants,
- exchange of experience and information related to land valuation,
- exchange of practical experience in the field of geodesy, cartography and cadastre.

2. The Participants may also agree on other forms of cooperation.

### **Provision 4 - Coordination**

1. Matters concerning the implementation of this Memorandum and the development of cooperation shall be discussed at the bilateral meetings, convened by mutual consent at the initiative of either Participant.

2. Within one month from the date of entry into force of this Memorandum, the Participants will provide each other with the necessary information about their designated contact persons responsible for coordination and implementation of the cooperation under this Memorandum.

### **Provision 5 – Legal framework**

1. All activities under this Memorandum will be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the national legislation of the Participant's states.

2. Information obtained through cooperation under this Memorandum shall be used exclusively for the purposes of implementing the agreed activities.

3. This Memorandum will not affect any other agreements or arrangements concluded between the Participants.

4. This Memorandum is not an international treaty and does not establish any rights or obligations in accordance with international law.



## **Provision 6 – Settlement of Differences**

Any disputes that may arise regarding the interpretation or application of this Memorandum will be resolved amicably through consultations and negotiations between the Participants.

## **Provision 7 - Amendments**

Amendments to this Memorandum will be made on the basis of mutual written consent of the Participants.

## **Provision 8 – Entry into force and duration**

1. This Memorandum shall enter into force on the date of its signing. It shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and will thereafter, automatically be renewed for a successive period of five years, unless terminated by either Participant.
2. Either Participant may terminate this Memorandum at any time by providing written notice of its intention to terminate to the other Participant at least three (3) months in advance. In such case, this Memorandum will cease to have effect three (3) months after the date of receipt of such notification by the other Participant.
3. The termination of this Memorandum will not affect the continuation and completion of activities agreed upon in accordance with this Memorandum and initiated in the period of its effect, unless otherwise agreed by the Participants.
